

STACY LEWIS WINS FIRST LPGA TITLE AT KRAFT NABISCO CHAMPIONSHIP

RANCHO MIRAGE, CALIF. – April 3, 2011 – American Stacy Lewis won her first LPGA tournament at the Kraft Nabisco Championship with a final round of 69 on the Dinah Shore Tournament Course at Mission Hills Country Club in Rancho Mirage, Calif., on Sunday.

Lewis finished with a cumulative score of 275 (66-69-71-69) to win at 13 under par on the 40th anniversary of the tournament.

Taiwan's Yani Tseng finished second overall at 10 under par. Americans Katie Furcher, Angela Stanford and Morgan Pressel tied for third at 4 under par apiece. Michelle Wie was fourth at three under par.

Heading into Sunday, Lewis trailed Yani Tseng by two strokes. Lewis was pressured by Tseng in the final round but a key 25-foot par save on the 17th hole helped solidify the victory for Lewis. The Rolex First-Time Winner finished her final round with four birdies and one bogey.

Fifteen-year-old Ariya Jutanugarn of Thailand was the top amateur of the tournament, finishing at three over par.

Lewis celebrated the victory by way of the ceremonial jump into Poppie's Pond. The Poppie's Pond traditional jump began in 1988 after Amy Alcott leaped into the lake after her victory.

The Kraft Nabisco Championship was Lewis' first overall title on the LPGA Tour. The Texas native posted four top-10 finishes in 2010, including second at the Tres Marias Championship and third at the Mizuno Classic in Japan. Lewis posted three top-20 finishes in major championships in 2010, including ties for 14th at the LPGA Championship and U.S. Women's Open.
